As a Participant in the programs, activities and events of the Ontario Soccer Association, their Districts, Leagues and Clubs, the undersigned acknowledges and agrees to the following terms.

The Ontario Soccer Association, their Districts, Leagues and Clubs, directors, officers, members, employees, coaches, volunteers, officials, participants, clubs, agents, sponsors, owners/operators of facilities, and representatives the 'Organization') are not responsible for any injury, damage or loss of any kind suffered by a Participant during, or as a result of, any program, activity or event, caused in any manner whatsoever including, but not limited to, the negligence of the Organization.

 Grass, turf, and other surfaces including bacterial infections and rashes

 Falls to the ground due to uneven or irregular terrain or surfaces

 Failure to properly use any piece of equipment or from the mechanical

 failure of any piece of equipment

 Extreme weather conditions which may result in heatstroke,

 supstroke or hyporthermia
- Extreme weather conditions which may result in heatstroke, sunstroke, or hypothermia Contact, colliding or being struck by other participants, spectators, equipment, or vehicles Vigorous physical exertion and strenuous cardiovascular workouts Exerting and stretching various muscle groups Travel to and from competitive and/or non-competitive events and activities which are an integral part of the organization's activities

FURTHERMORE, I am aware that I may:

- Sustain injuries in soccer that can be severe, cause spinal cord injuries and even
- Experience anxiety while challenging myself during the activities, events, and
- programs
 Come into close contact with other participants, including the possibility of accidental and unexpected contact
 Risk of injury is reduced if I follow all rules established for participation
- Risk of injury increases as I become fatigued

IN CONSDIERATION of the Organization allowing me to participate as a Participant, I agree: To assume all risks arising out of, associated with or related to my participation; To be solely responsible for any injury, loss or damage that I might sustain while participating; and to release the Organization from liability for any and all claims, demands, actions and costs that might arise out of my participating, even though such risks, injuries, loss, damage, claims, demands, actions or costs may have been caused by the negligence of the Organization.

Accident Insurance: Executing this agreement will not preclude you from accident insurance coverage, subject to the terms and conditions of The Ontario Soccer Association's insurance policy.

REGISTRATION AND REFUND POLICY - APPLIES TO ALL PLAYERS

- Payment of Registration Fees
 Full payment for registration must accompany the registration form
 Payment must be cash, cheque, debit, or credit card (where available)
 Payment is made out to Ottawa South United or OSU

- Every player is responsible for their own registration and payment of fees
 Ottawa South United S.A. shall NOT be responsible for any monies paid
 to a team, team coach, or team official and shall not entertain requests for any such refunds

- A) All refunds are:
 Subject to a \$30.00 administration fee
 The competitive tryout fee is non-refundable
- Must be made in writing, by email, or online by June 30th, and clearly indicate
- Do not ask a coach or other volunteer to pass on verbal requests, as they WILL NOT be accepted
- Refund requests made over the phone or through voice mail WILL NOT be
- accepted Refunds will only be issued once uniforms and equipment are returned to the club Refund cheques will be issued on the 15th of each month, beginning on June

- B) Full refunds (less the \$30 administration fee):
 Will be processed for requests prior to May 15th
 Where a player trying out for a competitive team is not selected and OSU is
- unable to provide a suitable alternative within the recreational program Where a player trying out for a competitive team is not selected for a specific team and player decides to leave OSU immediately after tryouts Where a Developmental or Recreational player identifies a specific geographic site and OSU cannot accommodate the request

c) Partial refunds (50%, less the \$30 administration fee):

- Will be processed for requests between May 15th and June 30th
- Where a player suffers a season ending injury, attested to by the attending physician prior to July 1 st, the refund will be prorated by the number of games up to the time of injury, less any fees paid to leagues or governing bodies Apply to recreational players only, under the conditions of item B), above

D) Refunds WILL NOT be processed under the following conditions: Written requests received after June 30th

- Written requests received arter June 30
 Competitive players withdrawing after they have been offered and accepted a team assignment, NO EXCEPTIONS
 Where a player transfers to another club after OSU has registered them with the governing soccer organizations, NO EXCEPTIONS
 Where a player has been disciplined by one of the governing soccer
- organizations, the club or has outstanding debts to the club

E) All other refund requests will be assessed on merit

Outstanding Fines: A player will NOT be registered for their respective league if outstanding fines or fees are not addressed

Competitive Team Fees: A player will NOT be registered with the ERSL (Regional) and OYSL until the additional fee assessed to Regional and OYSL

* VOLUNTEERS — All Volunteers are subject to final Club approval. Any dispute of what constitutes a volunteer for Club Membership status is subject to the final decision of the Club's Board of Directors.

The Ottawa South United Soccer Association (OSU or the Club) is committed to protecting your privacy. You can visit most pages on our Web site without providing us any information about yourself. On some of our pages we do require personal information from you. This privacy statement explains our policy related to the collection, storage and distribution of this information.

What do we collect?

what do we collect?

On pages where we do require personal information from you we will clearly state that we are collecting this information and will provide a link back to this privacy statement. Most often this information is required for registration purposes, and as such includes demographic information used to contact you by regular mail, email or telephone. It also includes information required to deliver a quality soccer program. This may include, but is not limited to, program selection, age, gender, position, ability, equipment sizing, location preferences, and friend requests. In addition, energency medical information is required should an accident occur and medical assistance need to be provided. Any online financial transactions are processed by a secure third-party, and no information other than the amount paid and the date and type of payment are delivered to the Club.

How is your information used?

Your personal information is used for the following purposes:

- to ensure our site is relevant to your needs
- to deliver a quality soccer program, including building team rosters for coaches and other team volunteers to contact their
- to alert you to important dates, events and meetings
- to alert you to important dates, events and needings to register with the Club for a specific program we occasionally hire other companies to provide limited services on our behalf including mailing newsletters. We will only provide those companies with the information they need to deliver the service, and they are prohibited from using that information for any other purpose.

OSU may disclose your personal information if required to do so by law or in the good-faith belief that such action is necessary to:

conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on OSU

- protect and defend the rights or property of OSU and its
- act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of the OSU employees, users of OSU programs or services, or members of the public.

Control of your information

When you register, or otherwise give us personal information, OSU will not share that information with third parties without your permission, other than for the limited exceptions already listed. It will only be used for the purposes stated above

OSU is a volunteer based association. All volunteers and those engaged as contractors by OSU are subject to a reference screening process prior to any involvement with the club and access to your information. At all times, OSU will ensure that access to only the portion of the information required by the role, to complete the activities associated with that role will be permitted. These individuals include: Registrar, Schedulers, Coordinators, Coaches, Assistant Coaches and Managers, Trainers, Camp Counselors, Club's Board of Directors, Club Administrator, Club General Manager

Ottawa South United Soccer Association Player Agreement

I agree to abide by the fundamental rule that I will not do anything to jeopardize another player's safety. I will abide by the rules of soccer (FIFA) and Ottawa South United. If I am registered for the Saturday Morning Men's League, I acknowledge that it is recommended that I read the managers handbook, especially the sections entitled "Philosophy of the Adult's House League" and the "Rules" to obtain more information. This handbook can be found on the OSU website.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE - Any player acting in an aggressive or overly physical manner will be subject to disciplinary action which may lead to suspension. Aggressive Conduct is defined as: any physical force that injures or has the potential to cause injuries, or abuses any individual or property. Aggressive Conduct also includes any attempt to make threatening physical contact with another individual. This also includes any verbally or physically threatening demeanor towards any individual. Players are to respect each other. Those not respecting other players may face game suspension(s) and possibly suspension for respecting other players may face game suspension(s) and possibly suspension for the remainder of the season or for an indefinite length of time

No refunds will be given to any players suspended for the season.
